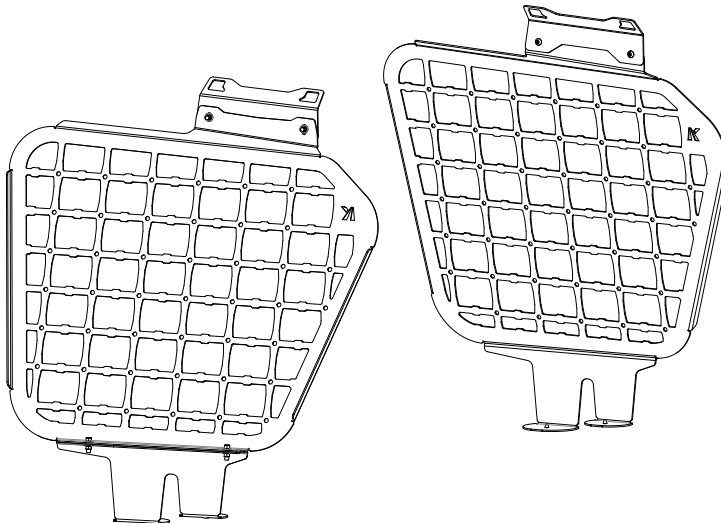

# Let's get to work.

## Assembling the Large Molle Panel

1. Ensure you have the correct foot for each Molle Panel before assembling. To check you have the correct corresponding Molle Panel, confirm that the foot profile match the base of the panel, and that the holes align.
2. Attach each foot to it's Molle Panel, using the provided M6 bolts and nuts.
3. Tighten all bolts to secure.

### If you're installing the Molles on their own or with a Light Cargo Barrier:

4. Loosely attach the provided handle bracket to the Molle Panel using the M6 bolts. The handle bracket should fold forward, in the same direction as the Molle Panel feet.

### If you're installing with a Standalone Shelf:

5. Set the handle bracket included with the Molle Panels to one side for safe keeping. A replacement handle bracket is included with the shelf.



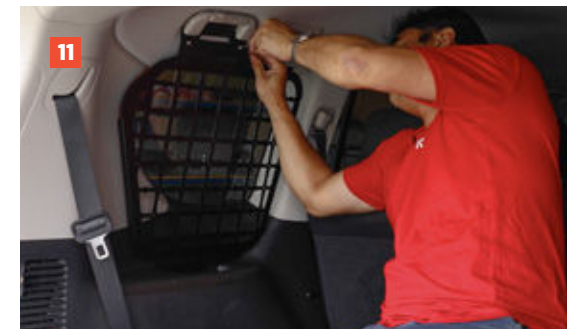
## Preparing the Vehicle

6. Pry open the plastic covers on the rear grab handles with a small flatblade screwdriver or trim tool.
7. Use a 10mm socket to remove the rear handles. Set aside.



## Installing the Molle Panel

8. Ensure you have the correct panel for each side. The 'K' should be positioned at the back of the vehicle. If you're intending on mounting anything to the Molle Panel, it's easiest to do it now.
9. Place the feet of the Molle Panel into the rear cupholders. The feet are contoured to fit, and the rubber stoppers will keep it secure.
10. Align the handles with the cutouts in the brackets. Align the bolts and locating pins with the holes in the roof, and reinstall by tightening to secure.
11. Make any necessary adjustments to the panel. While applying downwards pressure to the panel, tighten all bolts.
12. Repeat on the other side.
13. That's it, you're done!
